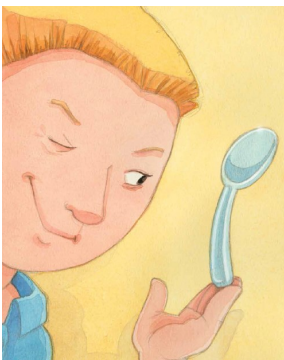
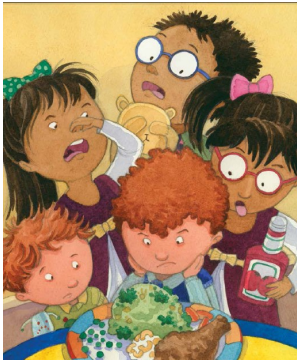

Kids' Table Cheese Ball

This cheese ball is creamy and delicious! Practice measuring by making it for your next family gathering. It's the perfect snack for the little kids' table!

- 16 ounces cream cheese, softened
- 2 cups shredded cheddar cheese
- 1 teaspoon garlic powder
- 1 teaspoon onion powder
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 cup chopped pecans*



In a mixing bowl, combine the cream cheese and cheddar cheese.
Add the garlic powder, onion powder, and Worcestershire sauce.
Refrigerate for 15 minutes, or until easy to handle.
Shape into a ball.
Roll in the pecans.*
Cover and refrigerate for several hours. Serve with crackers.

*If you have a nut allergy, instead of pecans, roll the cheese ball in chopped parsley, paprika, or shredded cheese
